

A.T. Oughton Scholarship

Application Opening Date: March 1

Application Closing Date: April 30

The scholarship is valued at \$25,000.00 for one year. The scholarship will be granted to a suitable candidate studying for a post graduate degree in a business or finance discipline with the successful candidate being eligible to reapply annually and hold the award for a maximum of four years.

The Scholarship recipient is expected to maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.0.

After graduation, recipients of the A.T. Oughton Post Graduate Business & Finance Scholarship will be required to work for the Liberty Group for the same period as the length of the scholarship (up to 4 years).

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. Candidates must be full-time students who have successfully completed their undergraduate studies and have been accepted into an accredited business or finance (accounting, human resources or IT) post graduate degree programme.
2. Scholarship candidates must have an up-to-date, sealed official university transcript from their undergraduate studies sent to the Scholarship Administrator via the BELCO Human Resources Department at 27 Serpentine Road, Pembroke HM07, Bermuda.
3. The scholarship will be awarded based on academic merit, good character and general, all-round social, community and academic excellence.

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ALL CANDIDATES

1. Offers of scholarship are subject to the timely completion of all application steps outlined.
2. Candidates must be Bermudian, aged 17 years or over, and have attended school in Bermuda for at least five years.
3. All candidates must provide the following:
 - a. Proof of Bermudian status
 - b. Details of academic achievements to date
 - c. Letter from the local educational institution verifying five years of schooling in Bermuda
 - d. Statement of financial costs from university attending
 - e. Typed, one page essay on your course of study, academic success and career objectives
 - f. Two written character references (from non-relatives)
 - g. A minimum of one academic reference
 - h. Acceptance letter from the educational institution (if not available at time of application, the applicant must attach a document indicating when the letter will be available)
 - i. Official transcript from educational institution currently attending
